Frequently Asked Questions

Where is the tournament?

It takes place in Ottawa and is held at various rinks in Ottawa, with most of the semi-finals and all of the finals taking place at the Jim Durrell Recreation Centre on Walkley Road

Where and what is District B?

District B was formed in Ottawa thru the amalgamation of Districts 6, 7 & 8. The tournament is hosted by all 5 associations of District B which are, West End, South End, Canterbury, Ottawa Centre, and the East Ottawa Minor Hockey Associations.

When is the tournament?

March 23rd to 25th includes the Initiation B, Atom A, B & C, Peewee A, B & C as well as the Bantam C levels.

March 30th to April 1st it will be Novice A, B & C, Bantam A & B and Midget A, B & C.

How much is the tournament?

The fee for 2012 is \$515.00.

How many games do we get and what is the format?

We run an A/B side style event with a 2 game minimum, up to 5 games possible in the larger divisions. All teams that get to a final get individual player medals, a team trophy and 1 player is chosen as an "Outstanding Player" and receives a plaque.

Is this a Tiered event?

Yes it is as the teams in District B play in a fully tiered league with A, B and C levels in all divisions, except Initiation. See full explanation in official rules and on registration procedure memo.

Who chooses the "Outstanding Player"?

The coaching staff selects a player for its own team at the end of the final game. The reason we keep putting "Outstanding Player" in quotations is because we really look at this as a contributor's award. It might not be the highest scorer or best player per se, but the one whose overall contribution got the team to the finals.

Can we use affiliated players?

Only in special circumstances as permitted, please see the full official rules for further information.

What is Roger's House and how much have you raised so far.

Roger's House is a Palliative and Respite Care facility for children located on the grounds of the Children's Hospital of Eastern Ontario (CHEO). This event has raised over **\$157,500.00** since the announcement of the creation of Roger's House.

What is required for registration?

Registration is considered complete upon receipt of a copy of your official **ODMHA (League) team list** (*signed by District registrar*) **electronic registration form**, and **payment of fee**. Payment of fee will hold your spot until the necessary paperwork is collected. (No post dated cheques)
